Proposal/Summary

The Audit Committee is to note the annual financial report interim audit results for the year ended 30 June 2024.

Background

The Shires auditor, Moore WA recently completed the Councils interim audit for the period ending 30 June 2024. The auditors spent three days at the Shire Offices on the 12th, 13th and 14th of June 2024 conducting the interim audit.

The purpose of the audit is to evaluate the overall control environment and to obtain an understanding of the key business processes, risks, and internal controls relevant to the audit of the annual financial statements.

The Auditor General signed off on the interim audit on the 24 July 2024.

Comment

The interim audit has identified three findings that are required to be addressed. The full report including the findings and management comments are included in the attachment.

The three matters identified have been allocated a moderate rating:

1. Grant revenue has not been recognised in accordance with AASB 15

2. Sundry creditor reconciling item not cleared promptly

3. Fixed assets reconciliation not performed correctly

Management comments have been provided in response to each of the findings and this is contained within the report.

While the audit findings have identified several areas requiring improvement, management is proactively addressing these issues to enhance compliance, accuracy, and control over the Shire's financial processes. The steps being taken demonstrate a commitment to maintaining the highest standards of financial management and transparency. Management will continue to monitor these areas closely, implementing the necessary adjustments and controls to ensure that the Shire's financial reporting remains accurate and reliable, thereby upholding the trust placed in the Shire by its community members.

Proposal/Summary

To discuss and seek Council's endorsement on concerns regarding a significant increase in the indicative audit fee for the 2023-24 financial report as notified by the Office of the Auditor General (OAG). Seek Council's approval to send formal letters to Minister for Local Government, LG Professionals WA, WALGA, Rick Wilson MP and the Auditor General addressing these concerns.

Background

The Office of the Auditor General has notified the Shire of an indicative audit fee of \$48,500 (excl. GST) for the 2023-24 financial report. This represents a substantial increase compared to the previous year's fee of \$30,340. The OAG has cited various factors for this increase, including cost recovery for their expenses, changes in auditing standards, and issues identified in prior audits.

As a small regional council with limited resources, this increase poses a significant financial burden. The Shire must consider the impact of this fee on our budget and operational capacity.

Comment

The Shire's financial constraints and limited staff resources make it challenging to accommodate such a substantial increase in audit fees. While the need for maintaining high audit standards is acknowledged, the expectations placed on smaller councils must be balanced with their capacity to meet these requirements.

In response to this notification, a letter has been drafted outlining our concerns regarding the audit fee increase. The letter requests reconsideration of the fee, as well as additional support and flexibility for small regional councils.

In addition, it is proposed that the Council formally communicate these concerns to the Minister for Local Government, LG Professionals WA, WALGA, and Rick Wilson MP, providing awareness, seeking advocacy, and requesting additional support for small regional councils.

Draft versions of letters to all parties have been attached for councils' consideration.
